- \_\_\_ Bath towel, washcloth
- \_\_\_ Toothbrush/toothpaste
- \_\_\_ Soap/shampoo
- \_\_\_ Comb/brush
- \_\_\_ Socks
- \_\_\_ Underwear
- \_\_\_ Bag for dirty clothes
- \_\_\_ Shorts
- \_\_\_ Short-sleeve shirts
- \_\_\_ Long pants
- \_\_\_ Swimsuit and towel
- \_\_\_ Insect repellent
- \_\_\_ Sunscreen
- \_\_\_ Flashlight with fresh batteries
- \_\_\_ Comfortable closed-toed shoes
- \_\_\_ Money for the trading post/commissary
- \_\_\_ Water bottle
- \_\_\_ Knapsack or backpack

Because of COVID-19, you may want to also bring the following:

- \_\_\_ 2-3 cloth face coverings (sewn mask, bandana, or buff)
- \_\_\_ Personal hand sanitizer

- Be sure you have your name on all of your equipment and clothing.
